RACHAEL CABRAL-GUEVARA ENDORSED BY WRTL

In addition, Cabral-Guevara has served as a senior lecturer at UW-Oshkosh for more than a decade. Her role at UW-Oshkosh includes instructing more than 90 students in both classroom and clinical nursing.

Cabral-Guevara lives in Neenah and is mother of four. She is a Neenah Rotary member and volunteer at Alliance Elementary School.
