FVI's ED PERKINS ENDORSES RACHAEL CABRAL GUEVARA FOR 55th AD

County GOP Exec Member and Fox Valley Initiative's Leader Endorses in GOP Primary

[NEENAH, WI...] The Assembly campaign of Rachael Cabral Guevara today announced the endorsement of Ed Perkins, a member of the Outagamie Republican Party Executive Committee and leader of the conservative Fox Valley Initiative.

Perkins, a Outagamie County Republican Party Executive Committee Member, said he knows "Rachael has the support of many Republicans along with many local Republican leaders."

She earned a Masters in Science Nursing from UW-Milwaukee and a Bachelors of Science in Nursing from UW-Oshkosh. In addition, Cabral Guevara has served as a senior lecturer at UW-Oshkosh for more than a decade. Her role at UW-Oshkosh includes instructing more than 80 students in both classroom, clinical, and labs on clinical nursing.

Cabral Guevara lives in Neenah and is mother of four. She is a Neenah Rotary member, volunteer at Alliance Elementary School and Boy Scout volunteer.
